Most modern minimally invasive pain therapies.

Back pain is a widespread disease. A CT-supported back pain therapy is a gentle alternative to surgical procedures and allows targeted treatment of back pain.

Minimally invasive pain therapy has been a successful method for the targeted local treatment of back pain for many years.



Periradicular therapy (PRT)

Periradicular therapy (PRT) is used to treat nerve root irritation syndromes. These are often the results of a herniated disc, which leads to irritation of the affected nerve root.

For whom is the examination suitable?

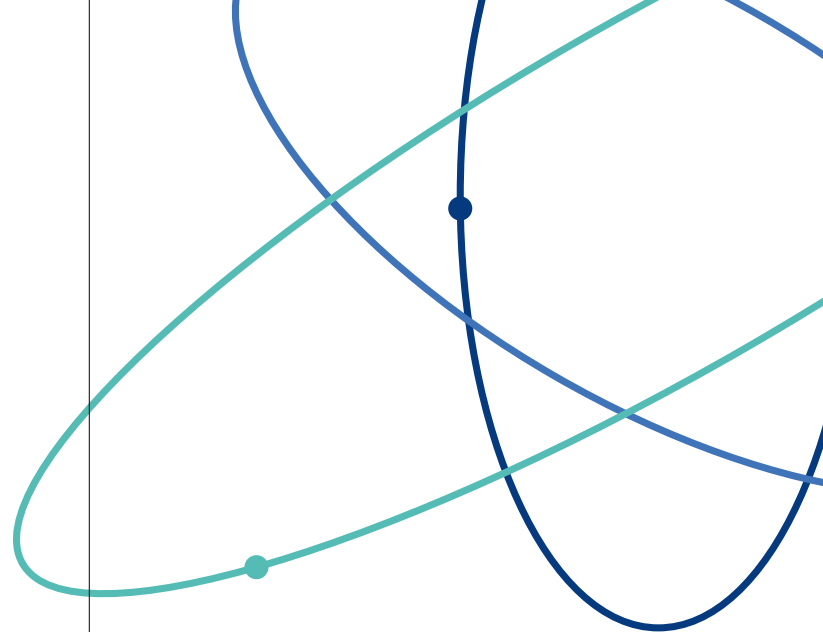
PRT is used in particular for acute pain conditions of the lumbar spine. This is useful if drug therapy or physiotherapy does not achieve the desired success.

The course of treatment

The examination can be performed on an outpatient basis. After repeated skin disinfection, a very thin needle is inserted in the prone position under CT control exactly at the site of the pain and pain-relieving medication (local anaesthesia) and anti-inflammatory cortisone is administered. If after the first treatment you are not completely free of pain, but feel a clear improvement, this treatment can be repeated several times. The therapy is largely painless and, if used correctly, usually without any significant side effects.

Aim of treatment

The treatment should have a positive effect on the so-called pain memory in the long term, so that no chronic pain can develop in the first place. Due to their analgesic and anti-inflammatory effect, the drugs lead to rapid relief and can positively influence the course of the disease in the long term.



What preparation is necessary

Please be sure to bring reports or previous images (MRI, CT, X-ray) with you to the examination. Please inform us about taking blood thinning medication. A determination of your current coagulation parameters by your referring physician is recommended.

Cost absorption

As a rule, the costs of the examination are reimbursed by the private health insurance companies. The statutory health insurances only reimburse the examination in the case of a referral by a specialist pain therapist. Otherwise, we can only offer you this therapy as a self-payer service (IGeL).
